CONSULTATION ON NEW WARD BOUNDARIES ACROSS BUCKINGHAMSHIRE

We consider that the existing 49 wards should be kept and the existing 3 councillors per ward be reduced to 2 councillors per ward in accord with the decision to retain 98 councillors instead of the current 147.

This would appear the most satisfactory outcome in terms of retaining adequate representation for wards and also preventing unnecessary disruption for the Council and its residents particularly at such a sensitive time as the local District Councils being replaced by a large Unitary Authority being based much further away from the majority of the Bucks populace.

It further would be prudent to await any revision of ward boundaries until the new government planning policy and Local Plan are introduced when a review would be more appropriate
