I am a local (Amersham) resident, and my comments are: 1). I think we should have 1 councillor per ward. I know the commission prefer larger wards with multiple councillors but I find you never know which councillor to contact and you don't have a single person who is your representative. It should be like MPs. 2). If there are to be multiple councillors per ward, however, it should be 2 each across the county. I don't see the benefit in having some larger wards with eg 3 councillors and some smaller ones with only 1. We should all be the same. 3). Chesham is split between 3 wards, two of which (Chess Valley and Chiltern Ridges) stretch across the countryside and the urban/rural parts have nothing in common with each other. Chesham is too big for a single ward, but at least give it a sensible north/south split or something. 4). Old Amersham should be joined with Amersham on the Hill - it makes no sense to stick Old Amersham in a ward which stretches across the countryside to Hazlemere. You could make space by putting Chesham Bois into south Chesham or something like that. 5). The Wycombe ward of Booker, Cressex and Castlefield looks like some gerrymandered boundary from America - the two parts of the ward are barely connected to each other! 6). I can't understand where the Bernwood name came from - surely it should have Haddenham in its name as that's its major population centre.
