Comment text:

Many of the towns in Buckinghamshire are not well served by the current boundries as they don't match the town outlines. For example chesham has three County wards. Chesham, chess Valley and chiltern ridges. But none of these wards have the majority of its area/residents in chesham. The chesham ward itself covers mostly the villages north of chesham, chess Valley and chiltern ridges cover mostly rural areas. This means that that no councillor focuses on what is right for chesham. It would be better to have wards covering the town, and others surrounding the town. Little chalfont is similar the parish council is served by 6 councillor but the parish mainly communicates to the ones for little chalfont and amersham common. This means that when an issue comes up for an area of cgalfont covered by chess Valley, the issue gets lost in communication and therefore the people in little chalfont covered by chess Valley are not well served by the boundries. Multi member wards are much preferred as it enables cover for when a particular councillor is I'll or unavailable. The wards should also aligh to the new 2023 parliamentary wards where possible.
