I would like to voice my opinion very strongly against the proposal to split the Beaconsfield Old Town (the original 'Beaconsfield' before the arrival of the railway when the New Town was established) into two separate areas for the purposes of local government.

It seems absurd to me that this very cohesive area, centred on the main road east-west through Beaconsfield, and comprising the Old Town Conservation area to the north and south of the A40, should be separated to make the southern area under the control of a Gerrards Cross dept, a town which is almost 5 miles away and has no real connection to Beaconsfield at all, from a line drawn arbitrarily in the middle of the A40, thus separating all properties south of that line (largely comprising the bulk of the older properties in the Old Town) into a Gerrards Cross-controlled area.

St Mary's Church in Windsor End – THE PARISH CHURCH OF BEACONSFIELD – will fall within this scope.

The Saracens Head, an old coaching inn, will also do likewise, together with a lot of other ancient buildings forming the original Town.

The Hall Barn Estate, part of Beaconsfield since the 1680s, will fall into this category, together with approximately half the properties belonging to the estate, making dealing with a holistic approach to conservation of the Old Town very much more difficult.

Two of Beaconsfield's sporting clubs – the 'Beaconsfield' Rugby Club and the Beaconsfield 'Football Club' should also remain in Beaconsfield.

I feel very strongly that ALL of the Old Town should be included in the same control as the rest of Beaconsfield.

Correspondingly, the parliamentary Constituency boundary should follow suit and include the whole of the Old Town, including the Hall Barn Estate and Wilton Park Estate (both historically IN Beaconsfield) into the same area. Surely, it is of vital importance that the Holtspur, Old Town, New Town and Wilton Park areas should be unified (as they are geographically) under one MP's control. This would make so much more sense than to split them up to be managed by a comparative outsider without an overview of the Town as an entity.
