### Comment text:

The Wing ward comprises mainly of a number of rural villages with similar issues and needs. However, it also includes Watermead and the growing development to the west of A413 and south of Martin Dalby Way. These two communities are really suburbs of Aylesbury - and are shown as such in the Aylesbury Garden Town plan. Arguably they would be better served by being represented by an Aylesbury councillor, for example to ensure they benefit from the town's transport network, and to avoid Wing councillors from being concerned with the detailed development of the Garden Town, which is of limited relevance to the rest of the ward. It is odd to include Whitchurch in Wing ward but to exclude Oving, which is more or less contiguous with Whitchurch. It would make sense to either include Oving and Pitchcott or remove Whitchurch, Hardwick and Weedon and create a new Quainton and Whitchurch ward to include the villages along the A413 and to the West. To the East, Mentmore, Ledburn and perhaps Cheddington arguably have more in common with Wing than with Invinghoe and the communities to the East of the West Coast Mainline / Grand Union Canal, which together form something of a boundary.
