Beaconsfield Ward should follow the Parish perimeter as regards Gerrards Cross because : 1. It improves democratic effectiveness by having the same border and is less likely to encourage political infighting so the council cannot blame the MP and visa versa . this is particularly relevant with Planning issues. Last years attempt to build on the only greenbelt due east of Beaconsfield is a case in point . This greenbelt is in Gerrards Cross Ward currently ! There is no incentive for remote Gerrards Cross to consider Beaconsfield public opinion . Currently part of Beaconsfield Old Town is in Gerrards Cross Ward ! 2. The parish border is much more in line with every day activity where Beaconsfield traffic and through traffic from Wycombe, Penn and Amersham uses the M40 spur at the Beaconsfield M40 Junction . Traffic and its consequences of air pollution and congestion are a major impact on Beaconsfield's quality of life and its residents need the political representation to have a say about it . The M40 is a designated air pollution management zone indicating its significance to Beaconsfield which receives the south westerly prevailing wind from the M40 . M40 traffic jams cause road congestion in Beaconsfield but NOT in Gerrards Cross town . 3. Gerrards Cross is much more aligned to Chalfont St. Peter rather than Beaconsfield . They both share a border and many more roads than with Beaconsfield . Therefor it is clear that from a democratic representation view as well as an administrative view it is better for the Beaconsfield Ward to be congruent with the Beaconsfield Parish .
