Comment text:

This email is to record my objection to the Boundary Commission's proposals in relation to Beaconsfield, Buckinghamshire: (i) divide the Beaconsfield Old Town into two and separates the parish of St. Mary's, the Rugby Club, Cricket Club, Market and half the Conservation Area from the rest of the town. (ii) confusingly, there is the additional proposal that Beaconsfield north of the A40 (so not all of the Old Town or Wilton Park) should join the Chesham and Amersham Parliamentary Constituency. Again, this would split parts of the Old Town and Wilton Park off from the rest of the Town and the town would have two different MPs. I support the alternative proposal as outlined below. ADD BACK: To see the town unified into the new constituency so that the Old Town is not divided into two and ALL of Beaconsfield including the whole Seeleys estate, Sandelswood estate and Knotty Green are included in the same new constituency. REMOVE: Any notion of the Old Town or Wilton Park, or any part thereof, joining Chesham and Amersham Parliamentary Constituency. The proposals have no historic or current connection, geographically or on any other basis. They would split the current communities in a destructive way, at a time when community cohesion is needed more than at any other recent period.
