An excellent presentation given by [REDACTED]. Is there a possibility of obtaining a more defined map of the Roydon Parish boundary and those of our closest neighbours, Nazeing and Epping Upland? The larger map does not define the parish definitions, sadly but I am looking on my iPad which has a small screen.

Our 3 wards, Broadley Common, Dobbs Weir and Roydon Village are Communities of Interest. Residents of the 3 wards attend Roydon activities, Roydon churches, support the shop, support the Village Hall (as well as St Christopher's Hall, Dobbs Weir) and the public houses in all 3 wards. Roydon Village has the only main line station within the EF District.

Our nearest neighbours, Nazeing and Epping Upland residents also support Roydon's activities and parishes meet to discuss issues of importance.

Three Councillors for each area/Ward (whatever size that will be) is ideal in that 3 Cllrs can argue for the Wards' needs but that is assuming our needs are the same. Currently Roydon feels that maybe the one Cllr does not argue for our needs sufficiently enough or the requests are either not heard or ignored.
