Dear Sir or Madam,

I worked in the St Nicholas community between 1998 and 2001, (St Nicholas is my favourite community in Stevenage), so I have a vested interest in the St Nicholas area.

Lincoln Road and Salisbury Road should absolutely be included in the St Nicholas ward.

Historically they were.

As both roads run alongside the St Nicholas Pavilion, playing field, park and Play Centre, the heart of leisure, recreation and play in the St Nicholas community, these streets should be in the St Nicholas ward once again.

Historically, the boundary between St Nicholas and Woodfield wards was to the northern edge of the playing field; it was a natural boundary.

It made no sense to move the boundary, dissecting the St Nicholas ward to include Lincoln Road and Salisbury Road in the Woodfield ward.

I understand that the boundary commission looks at the number of electors in each ward, but taking these two streets from the St Nicholas ward and including them in the Woodfield ward was bizarre, especially when streets at the other end of the St Nicholas ward meet the Woodfield ward, where there was no natural, geological boundary.

Please do record that I am on full support of this recommendation to return Lincoln Road and Salisbury Road to the St Nicholas ward.
