


Have your say on warding arrangements for parts of Chesterfield

In response to local feedback on our draft recommendations, the Commission has decided to carry out an extra period of consultation in the *Dunston* and *Whittington Moor* area and also the *Brocklands*, *Hasland* and *Spire* area.

It should be noted that the Commission believes it has received sufficient evidence relating to the rest of the borough to finalise its recommendations, so this consultation is focused on the areas mentioned above.

After we have considered all representations made to us during this consultation, we intend to publish final recommendations in **August 2022**.

The new electoral arrangements will come into effect at the local elections in **2023**.
