Changes to boundaries

We have lived in Tennyson Avenue in the centre of Chesterfield for the last 23 years. We enjoy the convenience of living so close to town in terms of the availability of cultural, leisure and entertainment facilities. However there is also a downside to living so close to town in terms of occasional anti-social behaviour, traffic issues etc.

The original proposal to create a new central Town centre ward (Spire Ward?) made by Chesterfield Labour Group and Chesterfield's MP seemed to make complete sense to us.
