A submission from Harper Green ward councillors

Current Harper Green ward councillors, Mistry, Haworth, Khurram have read the proposals and are aware that Farnworth North ward is one of the wards that is under populated. I have been asked to write.

There is an area north west of the boundary of the new Farnworth North ward. We feel this is connected through the way people live their daily lives to the first part of Farnworth North at Bradford Road, the Wilfred Andrews estate, Minerva Road, and the Flower estate. With the underpopulation being identified we felt we ought to recommend that further consideration be given to an area on the boundary of this Farnworth North ward. We would ask that this area is considered for inclusion if the Boundary Commission are able to further consider matters of under population;

A set of roads to the north west that includes;
Green Lane,
Bishops Road (numbers 122 to 150),
Oakleigh Avenue,
Some more homes on Bradford Road up to the road junction with Green Lane,
The rest of Greenland Road not currently included in Farnworth North ward,
Glenside Drive,
The new road of Westmorland Close,
Skelwith Avenue,
Rishton Avenue,
Brook Hey Avenue
Part of Rishton Lane

Much of that set of roads to the north west area is distinct and part of a local area which has semi detached and detached homes with pretty front garden with flowers and trees. Residents in the north west area use the few shops that are on Minerva Road in Farnworth North ward. There is a walking area centred at the Dell, just off Greenland Road, and many residents follow the surrounding circumference area of the Dell to walk regularly in the area. This is an example of how local residents regularly live between both Farnworth North and the north west footprint streets we have listed here. Many families, people who grew up together, people who went to school together, they live, everyday spread across the two areas of Farnworth North and this north west area over the border. Greenland Road this road itself, is in both the Farnworth North area and community connected to the Wilfred Andrews estate where Prestwood Road is. Greenland Road is also in the Lever Edge area where it is accessed form Green Lane and where people go to the Southfields Pub and use the shops and amenity on Rishton Lane. Ends. Sue Haworth
