Boundary Changes – Farnworth North.

The overall proposed boundary changes are significant improvement to the existing boundary.

As ward Councillors we have contacted our electors to seek their views on the proposed changes.

The outcome was those residents who reside on Bradford Road going towards Bolton coming down Minerva Road to junction of Green Lane and Bradford Road, Green Lane, up to Rishton Avenue on left consider themselves as residents of Farnworth and wish to remain in the new proposed ward Farnworth North..

We propose that instead of Greenland Road being the proposed boundary line it moved to Bradford Road, up Green Lane, up Rishton Avenue and Skelworth Avenue.

The residents living on Bradford Road, Green Lane, Rishton Avenue, Brooke Hey, Greenland Road, Oakleigh Avenue and part of Bishop Road will be in Farnworth North.

It will increase the number of residents in Farnworth North ward, but it will consolidate it and the boundary will be definitive.and composed.

Secondly our number is low compared Farnworth South and Great Lever and by our proposed change the number will be more balanced.

We hope the commission will consider our proposal.
