This is a sensible and efficient way to reduce the top-heavy 147-member unitary council down to 98. But with each Shire councillor representing around 4600 voters, it means that North Bucks (ie the county north of Aylesbury) will have only 16 of those members, against 62 in the rest of Bucks, Aylesbury included. I understand that this is proportional representation at work, but it means that those in North Bucks would be far less represented than those in the more heavily populated South Bucks.
