Comment text:

I am Councillor for the ward of Terriers and Amersham Hill and also live in the Ward. You have requested for further comments for the wards of Terriers and Amersham Hill and Totteridge and Bowerdean. As Councillor and resident for the ward of Terriers and Amersham Hill I may have best knowledge and I am well placed to propose changes to your proposals. I was born, went to local schools and have lived in Terriers and Amersham Hill all my life. I am a Governor at a local and my children have attended or are at schools in the Terriers and Amersham Hill Ward. I am also a Trustee of a well known Food Bank that is in Ward we help hundreds of families every week with food parcels. So I think I have a very good understanding for the area. Totteridge was part of the Green Hill and Totteridge ward until 2003, which included Terriers and Totteridge. I would like to see this Ward joined again and re-create the old 3 member ward of Terriers and Totteridge. My Ward of Terriers & Amersham Hill has areas previously were in the Bowerdean Ward and those areas should return to that ward. Both area have much in common like transport links, schools, doctor's surgery, shopping, mosques, churches, halls, and playground. The new 3-member ward will be including WS, WT, WU, and WV. I would suggest that parts of Bowerdean that are in Terriers and Amersham Hill, polling districts WG2 and WH2, would be moved to a new Bowerdean Ward to join WG and WH. While the two Totteridge polling districts of WW and WX would move to Terriers and Amersham Hill Ward. A new development at Terriers Farm of 873 electors is proposed which is split between Terriers and Amersham Hill Ward and Hazlemere Ward. I suggest that the whole Terriers Farm site should be move into the Hazlemere Ward. In result the changes would create a new 3-member ward which will have 12592 electors, a variance of 1.66%. Create new 1-member ward of Bowerdean with 4249 electors, a variance of 2.9%. Terriers Farm which is split between Terriers & Amersham Hill Ward and Hazlemere Ward, should be move into the Hazlemere Ward joining RK and RL, a 2-member ward with an electorate of 8792, a variance of 6.49%.
