### Comment text:

Penn, Tylers Green and Loudwater Your proposal makes a lot of points towards the link between Penn and Tylers Green but fails to mention the importance of Loudwater. Tylers Green and Loudwater have been long paired with each other and I am glad that the Commission is continuing to do so. Tylers Green and Loudwater are part of the same parish council, Chepping Wye who delivers in all areas it represents. They are part of the same Neighbourhood Action Group and Tylers Green residents often helping to run the Community Speedwatch Initiatives that take place in both areas. Furthermore, residents in both areas take an interest in its development particularly around the Gomm Valley Development which is located in between Tylers Green and Loudwater. Tylers Green and Loudwater are also connected by Hammersley Lane which is a clear road in between both those settlements. The Commission is right to point out the links between Tylers Green and the actual Penn bit as they share a residents society, WI and numerous events are organised between the two communities. Furthermore, Tylers Green and Penn have numerous sporting clubs which attract talent from across the area, with Tylers Green Residents even playing for Penn Street and Winchmore Hill despite the closer Penn & Tylers Green Sports Club highlighting the Community Links, thus highlighting community identity between Tylers Green and Penn Street/Winchmore Hill. Loudwater residents who go to Tylers Green and Penn for Sporting activity and for socials such as pubs. The Council proposal seeks to tackle the issue of electoral equality by reducing the variance for Penn, Tylers Green and Loudwater which is currently a big issues for the proposed ward. This proposal would reflect comments made in the first phase of the consultation and would increase the Buckinghamshire Council Representation for Penn Parish.
