### Comment text:

I have been elected member for Bargate ward for most of the past 40 years and have always lived in the Ward since 1976. Knowing the St. Mary's Street area (polling District 065 GD) community for all of that time and having spoken to many residents in that area feel the community link for this area is with the Holyrood AC, Chapel AF estates and City Centre AE and the Kingsland estate and not Bevois Ward. I feel that the following roads should be part of Bargate South and NOT the new Bevois Ward because of their community and geographical links; Golden Grove, James Street, Coleman Street, Ascupart Street, Clifford Street, Johnson Street, Chapel Street, Craven Street and St. Mar's Street. This would shift the proposed boundary from Chapel Street to the Six Dials road junction and increase the future size of Bargate South to approximately 11,500 voters which is within the 10% of the mean size, but would retain the strong community and geographical links. It would also keep the Kingsland estate including Broad Green, Cossack Green, Craven Walk, Palmerston Road, North Front and South Front community and geographical links with the St. Mary's Street area which at the moment share the same polling district 065 AD, but the new proposals would break the links.
