**Subject:** Boundary Commission Consultation regarding proposed enlarged Westdene and Hove Park ward

Good afternoon,

At our last Committee meeting of the Goldstone Valley Residents' Association (GVRA) Hove, committee members discussed your proposals for the enlarged Westdene and Hove Park ward. We agreed with your reasoning that there is a clear shared use of facilities, particularly the green spaces, between Hove Park, Three Cornered Copse (both currently in Hove Park ward) and Green Ridge, Coney Wood, and Waterhall (all 3 currently in Westdene ward), as we know residents that daily walk from the Goldstone Valley through the Three Cornered Copse (down towards Hove Park, or up and over Dyke Road Ave, towards Green Ridge and Coney Wood) to exercise in these green spaces. In addition, our members often see dog walkers and residents from Westdene ward, using the Hove Park ward green spaces ie Three Cornered Copse, Hove Park, so we can confirm that the facilities are shared and well used.

Furthermore we're aware that Goldstone Valley members use the facilities - Post Office, Newsagents, Dry Cleaners on Woodland Parade, on the other side of the Three Cornered Copse - there is a very well used path through the Copse, connecting Woodland Avenue with Woodland Drive/Woodland Parade.

As you identify there is no clear connection from the Goldstone Valley to the Hangleton & Knoll ward, but there is a clear and well used connection with Westdene ward from Goldstone Valley. Furthermore, there is a very clear connection to Hove Park with the Goldstone Valley - indeed we're aware that our members use Hove Park's facilities extensively, for the various activities, including Tennis, playground, dog walks etc and the local supermarkets here too, Waitrose and Lidl.

In conclusion we agree with your proposals for the enlarged Westdene & Hove Park ward.
