In relation to the proposed boundary changes. I have been a resident of Queenhill for the last Thirty Four years and during that time, we have been linked, both physically and spiritually, with the adjoining village of Longdon, including Parish council meetings, Church fetes and general matters of mutual interest. It has been suggested that we are to be joined with Ripple, a village situated the other side of the river Severn and a fourteen mile round trip to attend any meetings, assuming we are not cut off by flooding which is a regular occurrence. I do not see any reason why this change could be of any benefit to the hamlets of Queenhill and Holdfast, and the proposal clearly does not fulfill items two and three of the legal factors as defined in the documentation. Others in the village have submitted comprehensive documentation so I will not repeat statistics but this suggested change is of no benefit to our hamlets and would make life more difficult for many.
