Buckinghamshire Council Wards should not include both unparished and parished areas. The town of High Wycombe is unparished. We have a number of such anomalies where, currently, all three members representing a ward such as Tylers Green and Loudwater which has less than 25% of its electorate in the unparished area but all three councillors sit on the High Wycombe Town Committee which looks after the unparished area of High Wycombe. They also sit, as full members, on the High Wycombe Community Board. The council wards representing the unparished area should not overlap into parished areas. The number of councillors per ward, assuming no significant change in ward electorate, should be no more than two(2). Observing the work carried out by ward councillors and their attendance at meetings it appears that three(3) councillors are too many, but one(1) would be too few.
