### Comment text:

Faulty website - clicking on an area for boundary information has no effect. Not the most encouraging experience. I suspect this will be the same "false consultation" as previously experienced. Buckinghamshire council made their bid based on a significant reduction in the number of elected councillors that would result in a clearer voice and better representation for the electorate. Now faced with the reality that some of their number will be super-numerary and must cease to be councillors and suffer the loss of their various allowances and positions of influence they seek to upgrade the number by over 20%. It is a cynical ploy to preserve the power base of one particular party to the detriment of others. Some of the urban populations do not return Conservative councillors, while the less populated rural areas do. Anything that might provide for an effective opposition or voice, contrary to old shire voices is clearly unwelcome to the Buckinghamshire Council. I do not have the time or resources to take this any further, suffice to say I consider any increase from the Buckinghamshire bid document to be both disingenuous and undemocratic.
