Comment text:

I would like to object to the proposal to add Upper Welland to the Welland/Longdon parish, mainly on the grounds of the strong connection with Malvern Wells. It is apparent that proposal has been made for numerical convenience, with no attention paid to local links and geography. * Upper Welland is joined to Malvern Wells - there is a considerable gap between Upper Welland and Welland. * The most used route to the rest of Malvern is via the Wells Road (A449) rather than via Welland. * It is difficult to see the logic behind including Kings Rd, Homestead Close, Woodlands Close etc, which are all very much part of Wells * Similarly, it is difficult to see the logic behind separating facilities in Upper Welland, such as the village green, the playing fields and the children's play area from Malvern Wells, and vice versa, with the village hall etc., in Malvern Wells from Upper Welland. We are told that the arrangement with Malvern Hills Trust, under which we have discounted car park annual passes, would not apply under the proposal. Can this be confirmed? Would we still have to pay the MHT proportion of the Council Tax? Was this taken into account when the suggestion was made?
