Think that central could be extended to include the ten streets and L3. Residents on the front in L3 see themselves as part of City dwelling. Or extend Riverside but make the boundary slimmer so it is genuinely Riverside. Residents living along the front and beside the Mersey have a lot in common concerning environment; heritage; water (blue space * the docks) and green space - the need to ensure that development is conducive to a good life; neighbourhoods; communities; parks and not ghettoised by get rich quick developers who give nothing back but derelict legacies.
