Most are within walking range Unifying Jennetts Park is sensible.but attaching them to Binfield North is questionable as they are separated from Binfield by the lead road to the 329M which has no crossing points. Priestwood and Garth. Adding Quelm Park is not sensible as Quelm Park has no road links to Priestwood and Garth, rather uses Binfield or Warfield for schools and centres. I support the original Bracknell Council proposals. Town Centre I agree with the Borough Council's opposition to a one-member ward and with the recommendation by the Council. To get a 2-member ward, it is proposed by the Council to include the Parks into this ward, moving it from the suggested Bullbrook ward. Bullbrook The proposal to remove the area /roads round the Elms Recreation ground and move to Warfield. The Elms is one of the only two Recreation parks owned by Bracknell Town Council and not leased from the Borough. The Elms and the surrounding roads need to be reallocated to a Bullbrook as recommended by the Borough Council. The other proposals,with any adjustments made in the review are fine.
