I would like to raise my objections to the proposed boundary changes for Horsehay. The proposal suggests splitting the historic village of Horsehay in two which would mean two councillors for one village and potential conflict of interest fir residents. The Boundary Commission says : When carrying out an electoral review the Commission has three main considerations: • Improving electoral equality by equalising the number of electors that each councillor represents. • Ensuring that the recommendations reflect community identity. • Providing arrangements that support effective and convenient local government. The present proposals achieve the first objective but fails completely with the second and (in my opinion) also the third. The alternative proposal put forward by Cllr. David Hopkins is a far more reasonable proposal and still achieves the required electoral boundary objectives.
