### Comment text:

As a former resident of Horsehay, I am shocked by the proposal to dismember Horsehay by arbitrarily splitting it between two wards. The new proposed boundary between 'Horsehay and Lightmoor' and 'Dawley and Aqueduct' makes no sense to people who live in the area. I find it bizarre, for instance, that Horsehay Pool and the surrounding houses (where I used to live) have been placed in Dawley and Aqueduct. The pool is at the heart of historic Horsehay. Similarly, Spring Village is an integral part of Horsehay and yet has been placed in Dawley and Aqueduct. The proposed ward of Horsehay and Lightmoor contains little of what people in the area would consider to be Horsehay. I think these proposals strike at the heart of one of the stated aims of the boundary review: 'Ensuring that the recommendations reflect community identity'. I urge you to reconsider these proposals.
