Comment text:

In the past 20 years or so the old hospital cluster has been redeveloped to create large new communities with their own identity but divided and inefficient representation in the council. The estates of Clarendon, Manor, Livingstone and Noble could form their own ward called Horton with boundary changes to the north-west of Stamford and south of Ruxley and south west of Court being moved inward to accommodate the new ward. The residents of Horton and their representative councillor(s) will have particular interest in the western area of the borough to include the HCP LNR and adjacent open land. This western part of the borough is a 'forgotten' area being effectively divided between 3 wards and without a single voice for what is now a significant population centre. For instance recent years have seen changes to the traffic in this area (Horton Lane has been allowed to turn into a race track) causing concerns which are divided amongst current councillors and not being addressed by one voice. The reduction in sizes of current wards (adjacent to proposed Horton ward) would allow for merging to achieve efficiency and perhaps achieve overall reduction in councillors. Please consider this.
