### Comment text:

Based on the current sizes below are my reflections on what could be done. The Key issue appears to be the various now building sites principally those on the hospital cluster, but also on Nescot and the flats in town. I am advised that the aim is to have 35 councillors representing 1700 people each across 14 ward allowing 2 Councillors per ward. This seems acceptable as I assume some will be retaining 3 Cllrs per ward to reduce the need to change. i.e Court looks OK with 3 as does Nonsuch. Keeping 3 in College would allow Town adjustments. create new ward from Hospital Cluster to Reduce Ruxley allowing re-alignment in Ewell Return Stamford to original size by removing Hospital cluster add to new ward Return Court to Original without Parkview ( could keep Livingstone Park but may also help to move Gibraltar crescent back to Court to reduce West Ewell) Move new Nonsuch to Ewell on the Nescot site Take JC from Ewell to accommodate the Nonsuch move and return to Town / College Town transfer St Martins area to College Remove Dalmeny from Woodcote to Town due to road access. The Reigate road as a Boundary between Nonsuch and College may be an option for Longdown and Ewell downs road This could then allow woodcote to represent the roads nearest the Downs. If that makes Woodcote too big then the Dorking Road can act as a division moving its side roads such as the Convent and Whitehorse drive back to Town. Ebbisham as an estate could also be used to balance Stamford/Woodcote/Town having removed the Hospital cluster. Note I live on Whitehorse drive and feel closer to Town than woodcote as Langley Vale is a drive away and has its separate village feel as does the Woodcote estate.
