I am writing to oppose the proposal to merge the Pixham Ward with Dorking North, rather than with Mickleham and Westhumble.

Pixham is a small hamlet at the more rural end of Dorking, separated from the main town by the A24. There is a strong community in Pixham, more akin to both Mickleham and Westhumble than Dorking North, with many individual localised events taking place many of which are centred around the Old Pixham School which the community runs like a village hall.

By merging Pixham with Dorking North, this individuality may be lost and certainly not taken into account, when decisions are made which will affect this small area, which is quite unlike the area of Dorking North.

I would like to add that I lived in Dorking North for 15 years before moving to Pixham, and there is no comparison between the two. I have never lived in an area (of a town) quite like this that has such a positive sense of community, neighbour awareness and friendliness: Pixham should be merged with similar, like-minded small areas such as Mickleham and Westhumble.

I hope my comments will be taken into consideration.
