We have read the document outlining the new boundaries for MVDC Local Government and wish to voice very strongly our objection to the recommendations made.

In the first place to split St Nicolas Church and Bookham Baptist Church into two different districts shows a complete disregard for the Villagers of Bookham. These two churches and surrounding area are the main focus for Bookham Village and therefore should never be split in half. It is even more worrying that the people over-seeing the review have no knowledge of the village and how it operates.

We are a very close community and Bookham South and Bookham North are the basis of the Village of Bookham and should therefore remain as voting districts and not be split up into part of Fetcham which has nothing to do with the Bookham Community.

We are sure Fetcham Village residents are also unhappy about this proposal and it looks as if a pin was stuck into a map without any thought of the consequences for both people living in the villages of Bookham and Fetcham.

The LGBC has failed to meet their own objectives with the new Eastwick Park ward by failing to maintain village and conurbation identities.

We therefore urgently ask that a further review is undertaken before any boundary changes as suggested are implemented.
