Comment text:

I wish to object to the proposed Halton-with-Aughton and Lower Lune Valley ward with proposed three councillors. This would be a huge geographical area to cover and should current planning applications be successful in East Lancaster would also see urban and rural areas very different in the same ward. I believe this area should be made up of three separate wards each with one councillor each. The smaller rural wards would make councillors more accessible to those they represent. One suggestion is that the three new wards could be Halton-with-Aughton (one councillor) Wray & Lune Valley (one councillor) and Caton with Brookhouse (one councillor) Similarly I would like to see Ellel ward split roughly one councillor ward to the west of the M6 (Galgate and Cockerham ward?) and one ward with one councillor to the east of the M6 (Dolphinhorne ward?) These smaller rural wards would make it easier for a councillor to respond to local needs and help citizens feel closer to local democracy.
