### Comment text:

Thanks for giving me the opportunity to comment. Please note I am the local MP and a Conservative - but my motivation here is for the Wards to fit peoples sense of "place" and for the election results locally to reflect the actual will of the people which the current boundaries do not produce: • Istead Rise should not be with Cobham and Luddesdown, it should be with Painters Ash or left alone. Reasons: Parished vs Unparished areas & Istead is historically Northfleet. • Chalk and Westcourt should be stay as proposed. Reasons: Westcourt is historically Chalk and it has a shared history, they share the parade of shops near Lion Garage & any boundary between the two would be arbitrary and split the Westcourt community. • The greater Perry Street area should be a three-ward seat, combining BF polling district with the proposed Coldharbour ward. Reasons: BF polling district is separated from Rosherville by the railroad, it is part of the Perry Street area and should be represented as such. Rosherville would then have 2 seats and Perry Street 3 seats. • The whole of Meopham should be represented together. Reasons: the proposed boundaries will create confusion especially on Wrotham Road and will lead to bad local governance. The boundary on Wrotham Road seems very arbitrary and confusing and will split communities. The boundary should not wind in and out of Wrotham Road. • The one-way system in Town along with Homemeade Court, Gravesham Court, William Street, and Wellington Street should be in the Town ward – they are within the town, not Windmill Hill or Whitehill. Bronte View should be moved to Whitehill and Windmill Hill because of lack of road access to the rest of Town ward. • The houses on Whitehill Hill should be in Whitehill and Windmill Hill, they are part of the hill on which the community is formed. • Gravesend Cemetery should be in Woodlands ward as it should be in a Gravesend ward, not a Northfleet ward.
