Regarding the 'Parish Meeting' of Wisley Village: Wisley Parish is largely characterised by the presence of the renowned RHS Garden and its land ownership of much of Wisley Village and the surrounding land. Occupying the northernmost part of Guildford Borough, and definably rooted in the history of Lovelace Ward, it is isolated from Ockham to the east by the A3 barrier, and with close transport links west to Woking Borough, and an affinity with Ripley to the south by virtue of the Ockham gyratory and local road network. The future of the M25 J10 road scheme, also Wisley Airfield will determine Wisleys future success - it is to be hoped that any benefits from the outcomes of these schemes will support the regional importance of Wisley and that any boundary changes will not further undermine the position of Wisley as a major contributor to both Guildford and Woking. The Royal Horticultural Society have contributed to the Lovelace NHP and will take an active interest in the adoption of that Plan, the forthcoming Local Plan review and the draft boundary changes as they are published.
