Comment text:

The Herbert Collins Residents Association (HCERA) notes with concern that Southampton City Council's submission for proposed boundary changes between Bassett and Swaythling would divide the Ethelburt Avenue (Bassett Green) Conservation Area and its associated Residents Association area into two. We request that whatever proposal is chosen, the whole of this area (ie Ethelburt Avenue, Field Close, Summerfield Gardens, 51-79 Bassett Green Road, 2-34 (evens) and 1-43 (odds) Leaside Way and 9-43 Stoneham Lane be kept within the same ward. The Conservation Area is subject to an Article 4 Direction which removes a lot of permitted development. If the Conservation Area is split between two wards then we shall be involving two sets of ward councillors with these complexities. In the attached file, we suggest a ward boundary that leaves the whole of the Conservation Area in Swaythling. We have more in common with Swaythling than Bassett. Our local shops are in High Road, Swaythling, the buses we use run along Stoneham Lane into Swaythling and then on to Portswood. A further merit of our ward boundary proposal is that it leaves properties on the west and east sides of Stoneham Lane and the side roads of Greenways and Channels Farm Road in the same ward of Swaythling. The west side has little in common with Bassett.

Suggested ward Boundary of Bassett to ensure that the whole of the Ethelburt Avenue (Bassett Green Estate) Conservation Area is within Swaythling Ward.



Description of the Boundary

The boundary between Bassett and Swaythling ward is along Bassett Green Road from the west and then turns north onto the adopted public footpath at the rear of 79 Bassett Green Road and continues along this footpath to the rear of properties 79 to 63 Bassett Green Road. Following the footpath it runs to the rear of the 16 to 30 Leaside Way. It passes to the rear and side of 34 Leaside Way crosses Leaside Way and then beside the side boundary of 43 Leaside Way and the rear boundaries of 1 and 3 Summerfield Gardens. From there, it proceeds directly to the Southampton City boundary in the ground of St. George Catholic College.
