Comment text:

Why not make the Heaton-w-Oxcliffe Parish boundary and the Scale Hall proposed boundary match, particularly on the Grosvenor Park Estate. The bottom of Lune Drive, Bishopdale Close, Hyndburn Close and Hodder Avenue have no direct connection with Torrisholme, but are accessed through the Heaton-w-Oxcliffe parish. The A589 / Morecambe Road creates a real barrier to this part of Grosvenor Park and would be a suitable dividing line for both the Lancaster Wards and the Parish Wards. As you will see in the screen shot taken showing the City Boundary and the Parish Boundary, there seems to be no logical reason for the boundary line to cut through the estate as it does. Perhaps in the distant past there was a reason for this, but for today it only confuses the issue of the parish and political boundary.
