Comment text:

I refer to the changes for Penn./Graisley Wards. I strongly feel that boundaries for the Penn Ward should remain as they are. The test around clear boundaries is definitely compromised as relinquishing both sides of Coalway Road to Graislely and taking both sides of Goldthorn Hill and Coton Road to Blakenhall leaves Penn Ward with no strong, clearly identifiable boundaries. The other test around 'reflecting community identity, has been ignored with Penn losing the only Catholic Church in the community. The community shopping area, shops at the bottom of Coalway Road, are well used and are part of the 'character of Penn' Graislely already has its own community shopping areas. The proposal to maintain Penn Ward as it is, will still leave Councillors with electors within the range of 10% of the average of electors over the forecast period of 2026.
