Moving the South side of Coalway Road out of the Penn Ward into the Graislely Ward removes a very clear boundary with one that is difficult to follow. It is very clear now - why cause confusion? The test around clear boundaries would be compromised by this change. The current boundaries reflect the community identity of those areas. Those streets that are proposed to move fit with Penn but not with Graislely due to the size and type of housing. The submission talks about the number of electorates per councillor. Whilst Penn is a little higher than Graislely, it is not by much so I cannot see why this would cause a boundary change. Penn Ward has some lovely shops on the corner of Coalway Road, these are well used by local people and are part of the character of the Ward. There is no reason to move these into Graislely Ward that already has its own community shopping areas. Penn Ward has similarities with Merry Hill, Tettenhal Regis and Tettenhall Wightwick, these three Wards are already recommended to stay as they are by LGBCE and the local council to remain as they are. Again, I have to ask why you would then make confusing and illogical changes to Penn Ward? I have stated a number of objections to the change of boundary on Coalway Road and hope you will reconsider this recommendation.
