PENN Ward changes.

We wish to protest most strongly to the proposed Ward boundary changes which would relocate our property from Penn Ward to Blakenhall Ward.

We have only very recently learned of the proposed change which has not been notified to us by either Government or our Local Authority.

We chose to live in Penn in our current property more than 40 years ago and do not wish this change to occur.

Penn Ward has similarities to Tettenhall, Wightwick and Merry Hill Wards and these particular Wards are already recommended by LGBCE and Local Authority to remain unchanged.

We are concerned that the change will depreciate the value of the property which we chose to invest in for our and our childrens future.

The test around clear boundaries is definitely compromised by this proposed change and would leave Penn Ward with no strong and clearly identified boundary.

The other test around "reflecting community identity has been ignored eg Penn will lose St. Michaels Catholic Church which is highly supported and well loved by Penn residents.

We trust that our objection will be recognised and noted and that this unnecessary decision of change will be reversed.
