As a Fant resident who has raised a safety concern regarding emergency vehicle access and the safety of children almost being run over I would strongly urge that there be radical changes to boundaries. Fant needs to be radically reduced in size or better yet absorbed into neighbouring Wards so we can be served by Councillors doing their job properly. The safety issue raised with Councillor Paul Harper in June 2021, has seen no communication in return to 7 emails since August 2021. Ambulances are being obstructed by parked cars on a private road and therefore the Council is failing Under The County of Kent Act 1981, section 53. The easy access bin lorry is also obstructed repeatedly. I'm also concerned by Councillor Paul Harper's lack of response considering a child was almost killed by a car on the private road. We need a touch of traffic/parking management, permit parking bays to keep the access 'T' kept clear of obstruction. I have a clear interest in community safety and I fondly remember Stephen Paine's decent work when he took effective action regarding speeding vehicles on Upper Fant Rd. Can Fant residents contact other Councillors if they are being underserved?
