I live in Sandway. I can walk to Lenham in 20 mins. Everything I do, I do in Lenham, usually daily. I rarely go to Headcorn now that I don't have to go to London. It's half an hour by car if you are catching a train. I haven't been there this year at all. I don't shop there, since the parking became a nightmare, & the road to Headcorn is narrow, the traffic is often bad now that Headcorn has had so many new houses, plus the enormous gypsy camp that sprang up without permission, and cars go too fast for it - there were four deaths on it very recently. I do not want to be in Headcorn's ward. I want to remain with Lenham. One can't help feeling that this particular boundary change is a vindictive council stitch-up to split Lenham Heath from Lenham and make our representatives more remote, just as we fight against a brutal and misguided attempt by Maidstone Borough Council to inflict a whole new town here. I know our ward representatives and vote for them despite my party preferences because I know they are out and about in the Lenham area and really care. I have no idea who represents Headcorn and they won't care about us. Boughton Malherbe, Pope's Hall, Bowley Lane and Liverton should certainly be with Lenham.
