From the information I have seen my understanding is that you are proposing to do away with the Loose Parish Council whereby Loose will effectively be cut in two with the area in which I live being allocated to Tovil. I do not consider it appropriate to cut Loose in half 'to make up numbers'. Loose should remain as it is. If Loose has to be included with another area, and it seems this decision has been made by Maidstone Borough Councillors rather than the public, then it should be affiliated to Boughton Monchelsea and not Tovil. This would surely provide the numbers you wish to achieve with the new housing developments there. The alternative to this would be to link with Coxheath given the two are virtually joined together by the large estate constructed at the Coxheath end of Well Street. Cars from this estate will use Well Street as their access to Maidstone. Coxheath residents do not want to be affiliated to Marden given the distance these two villages are apart and therefore Loose with Coxheath is a far better alternative to the areas which have summarily been decided upon by Maidstone Borough Councillors. We will be in a situation where two different local council wards will have jurisdiction over such things as housing, recreation, local amenities, which is bound to be detrimental to the area currently designated as Loose and especially so if the split remains as you are proposing. I hope that you will give thought to reconsidering the boundary lines for Loose as what is on the table is not an appropriate solution because you are splitting a village which is ridiculous and unacceptable to those living in the Loose area.
