The boundary between the proposed wards of Chalvey Grove & Cippenham Meadows needs redefining. Raleigh Close was built in 1986 as part of the Windsor Meadows Estate. Under the proposed boundary, Nos. 1-5 & 7-19 Raleigh Close are in Cippenham Meadows Ward whilst the remainder of Raleigh Close is in Chalvey Grove ward. Should Raleigh Close be kept intact in a single ward? Bennett Close was built in 1980 & is regarded as part of the Windsor Meadows Estate by a majority of local residents, therefore should Bennett Close remain in the proposed Chalvey Grove ward? Proposed ward names:- Windsor Meadows Estate was built in 1986-1987 & was included within the original Cippenham ward up until 2003 before forming part of the Cippenham Meadows ward between 2004 to 2013 & from 2014 to 2022. Most Windsor Meadows Estate residents don't regard themselves as residing in Chalvey but in Cippenham! Montem Primary School has only been at it's Chalvey Grove location since 1972 so surely a more historical name for the proposed Chalvey Grove ward would be Cippenham Manor ward named after the site of the Earl of Cornwall's manor in Telford Drive? The proposed Cippenham Meadows ward no longer includes the Windsor Meadows Estate so perhaps a new name might be more appropriate such as Cippenham Village ward which includes the historic area around the village pond in Lower Cippenham Lane or just Cippenham South ward as it includes the new estates built around Earls Lane, Richards Way & Moor Furlong during the 1990's & the Eton Green Estate built during 2007-2013.
