Dear Slough reviewers,

I write to respond to your consultation; and to express my agreement with the proposal for 21 X 2 member wards as a good ward pattern for Slough Borough. This presents a clear system that residents can understand and ensures that all residents will have a choice of ward councillor that they can contact/raise issues with.

I support the proposals in your booklet for all the wards within the areas described as 'West Slough' and 'West Central Slough'. I also support the new Hershel Park ward that will be bordered by the Chalvey ward - and the proposed boundaries for both wards.

I support the amendment by Slough Borough Council made at its full Council Meeting on the 21st July for a different configuration of Slough Central ward and Upton-Lea ward - using Wexham Road as the boundary between these two wards up to the canal (as the Council set out in their amendment) is a clearer and more recognisable boundary for local residents than the boundaries proposed in the LGBCE's consultation document. I therefore prefer Slough Borough Council's proposal/amendment for these two wards.

I do not know the east of the town so well, so I don't feel able to comment on the wards within the Langley and Colnbrook area.
