### Comment text:

I am writing to support the proposals for the wards in the north and east of the borough, in the proposals published by the Boundary Commission. The new Bradshaw and Bromley Cross ward makes much more sense, as I previous wrote, in terms of the use of services, and the inclusion of Bradshaw institutions, such as the cricket club, in the new ward. Equally, the new Breightmet ward, takes in the orphaned section of Bradshaw, which is traditionally Breightmet, and includes obvious Breightmet facilities and services, such as the Breightmet UCAN Centre. Wider afield, I'm pleased the commission has reintroduced the concept of South Turton. Although the wider area falls into a neighbouring borough of Blackburn with Darwen, the new ward takes in a significant chunk of the South Turton area, as supported by the signage of Bolton Council in the area. This equally allows the new Astley Bridge ward to better represent the communities along the A58, particularly around ASDA on the junction of the A666. In terms of services such as schools, I know the new proposals make much more sense, for example taking existing communities, for example school catchment areas more into account. I would like to congratulate the commission on their efforts and their improved mapping of the north and east of the borough.
