Comment text:

I would like to make the following comments regarding the proposed Lostock, South Heaton and Chew Moor ward: 1. It seems illogical to move the streets at the corner of Beaumont Road and Wigan Road (those of the Oldstead Grove and Cranberry Drive estate out of the existing Heaton & Lostock ward when the logical and natural boundary for that part of the ward would be Wigan Road, as at present. Indeed the residents of that block are much more of a community with the adjoining Ladybridge Estate than the streets on the SE side of Wigan Road - Holmfield Green, Sutton Road, Addington Road, etc. 2. The same argument goes for the streets in the NE of the proposed new ward bounded by Devonshire Road, Chorley Old Road and Lonsdale Road. Again, it would make much more sense to leave Devonshire Road as the boundary between the two new wards as it is currently between Smithills and Heaton & Lostock wards. 3. The name of the proposed new ward is far too long and cumbersome. Why include Chew Moor in the name when the much larger are of the Ladybridge Estate is not? Naming is always difficult and being inclusive of the various parts of a ward always seems to be a problem. The one common feature of the proposed new ward is the Middle Brook (or Middlebrook) stream that runs through it. To make matters simple, inclusive and identifiable could I please suggest that the new ward be simply named "Middle Brook" or "Middlebrook".

I suggested Middle Brook (or Middlebrook) as an alternative. Another simple suggestion for the new ward's name would be "Beaumont".
