Comment text:

I am very much against the proposed boundary change removing Andrew Lane Park from Astley Bridge. As a resident of the estate surrounding Sharples Hall Drive/Thornham Drive, the park is very much a focal point for the community, where local schools provide work for display and where we celebrate Christmas, Easter, Remembrance Day and other events. Residents further away eg Templecombe Drive, are unlikely to have the same attachment to the park and such events will die out. In addition, as a long time resident of 30+ years, I consider Eagley Bank to be very much a part of my neighbourhood and attend the events they put on. It would make slightly more sense for the boundary to go up the centre of Blackburn Rd. Hall i'th'Wood is not part of Astley Bridge, it is clearly more closely connected to Tonge Moor. Most of the children on the estate go to Castle Hill, St Columba's or Tonge Moor schools, which are not in Astley Bridge.
