I have been made aware of the proposals to split the current ward of Astley Bridge and move the Templecombe/Whitehill areas and Eagley Bank into a new ward of South Turton. I very much object to these proposals which would split up the existing ward and split up our community. I think it is pointless and that there is no gain to be made in any form from this exercise. We have a strong community in Astley Bridge, with residents working together alongside ward Cllr's.
