I submit this objection on behalf of all of the residents on [REDACTED] Greystoke Drive, Astley Bridge Bolton; [REDACTED] The published proposals in regard to Astley Bridge will split up an existing community which has existed for over 100 years. Residents in Astley Bridge work together in the community, enjoying local parks, community events and many have lived within the boundaries of Astley Bridge for several generations. The proposals would also lead to the removal of Andrew Lane park from the ward. The park is a focal point of local events within Astley Bridge such as the community Christmas lights switch on organised by the Friends of Astley Bridge group and local Cllr's. Local residents do not have any connection to the newly proposed South Turton ward and there is no direct road access between areas such as Templecombe Drive. Residents in this area would either have to travel through Astley Bridge or leave the Borough entirely in order to travel to the rest of the new ward. Residents use the shops on Blackburn Road, which is the 'centre' for the local area. We do not wish you to split up the ward and divide our community and wish to express our objections to the current proposals in the strongest possible terms.
