I wish to register my own personal objection to the proposals published by the Local Government Boundary Commission in regards to Astley Bridge and the newly proposed ward of South Turton. The current proposals would in my view split up an existing, very long standing community. Astley Bridge has existed as a unique area for over 100 years, with many families living locally for generations. The proposals would remove Andrew Lane park from the ward, which is a focal point for the local community.
