We would jointly like to express our objection to the proposed changes which the Boundary Commission have put forward for the Astley Bridge ward. We are residents of the ward and feel that the changes being put forward will be detrimental for the area. Firstly they would split off residents that have lived in Astley Bridge for many years from a close knit community. Residents in Astley Bridge work well together and have a great track record of putting on some great events locally. These comprise the Remembrance commemorations, Christmas lights switch on, activity days at local parks for children and Easter egg hunts. Residents from across the ward engage in these events and many are members of the Friends of Astley Bridge community group. Secondly, while removing residents from an active community that they are very much a part of, the areas being moved into the South Turton ward would effectively being moved into an area with which there is no natural link and no community connection. Areas on the North end of Astley Bridge have no connection with Dunscur or Egerton in the way that they are involved in Astley Bridge. These proposals would only serve to divide a strong community and we see no reason that they should go ahead in their current format. [REDACTED]
